

SCRIPTURE READINGS

TODAY'S EPISTLE 1 Timothy 1:15-17 My son Timothy: This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief. However, for this reason I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show all longsuffering, as a pattern to those who are going to believe on Him for everlasting life. Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

TODAY'S GOSPEL Matthew 15:21-28 At that time, Jesus went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon. And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demonpossessed." But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us." But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!" But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs." And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table." Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour.

EMERGENCY EXPENSE - NEW FURNACE IN THE RECTORY

The furnace that heats the rectory broke down Tuesday, malfunctioning at near-dangerous levels. A new furnace had to be purchased. We were fortunate that the old furnace lasted as many seasons as it did. The new furnace cost \$6,975.00, including installation (and exempt from sales tax) – a significant withdrawal from our parish's available funds, especially following the necessary replacement of the windows and doors of the rectory last year.
