### Ceiling Repairs - Work Completed!

Thanks to the hard work of **Arnold's Contracting LLC**, the Dome, Cross and roof were all repaired this week. The Dome and Cross have also been repainted, so be sure to take a look outside. The interior ceiling repairs and painting have also now been completed.

Total project costs for all exterior and interior repairs were approximately \$6,000.00. These funds were paid from our Capital Projects Fund. We wish to acknowledge those who have given so generously to this project. May God Bless your generosity!

The next phase of our Temple Beatification is to proceed with the commissioning of the Pantocrator Icon, along with possible additional Icons and adornments. Cost estimates are in progress with the Iconographer.
