Ceiling Repairs - UPDATE!

Dear Faithful of Holy Trinity:

As many of you observed at Liturgy last Sunday, our cupola was leaking rather significantly. Unfortunately as the rains continued for much of this past week, the ceiling condition deteriorated. Our contractor who is working on the interior painting was able to inspect our roof, Dome and Cross. He found several areas of concern that need immediate attention before the painting work can be completed.

The cost of the repairs to the roof, Dome and Cross are approximately \$4,000.00. This amount is in addition to the agreed upon interior painting project of \$2,500.00. We wish to acknowledge those who have given so generously to this project previously. May God Bless your generosity!

The Council, in consultation with Fr. Alexey, approved funding from our Capital projects account to address the leaking roof area.

In light of the current situation, we are asking all to prayerfully consider making a contribution to replenish our Capital projects fund so that the Iconography may be completed in the coming months.
