While Holy Communion may only be received by prepared Orthodox Christians, our non-Orthodox guests are welcome to join us in venerating the cross and receiving blessed bread at the conclusion of the Liturgy. We also hope you will join us for the Fellowship Hour.

Today's Gospel reading is Matthew 25:31-46, the parable of the Last Judgment. It reminds us that while trusting in Christ's love and mercy, we must not forget His righteous judgment when He comes again in glory. If our hearts remain hardened and unrepentant, we should not expect the Lord to overlook our transgressions simply because He is a good and loving God. Although He does not desire the death of a sinner, He also expects us to turn from our wickedness and live (Ezek. 33:11).

The Annual Meeting of Holy Trinity Orthodox Church is TODAY following the Divine Liturgy. Please join us during the Fellowship Hour as we review the past year and plan for the next to come.

Chrismation of Denis Kingsley - Denis Kingsley will be received into the Orthodox Faith by the Rite of Chrismation next Sunday, March 10th during the Divine Liturgy.

Today is the last day for eating meat and meat products until Pascha, though eggs and dairy products are permitted every day during the coming week. This limited fasting prepares us gradually for the more intense fasting of Great Lent.

Cheesefare Brunch: Next Sunday March 10, 2019 after Divine Liturgy. Everyone is invited to share in the brunch and fellowship before we enter the Great Lent as a parish family. Please bring your favorite non-meat dish to share.
