**Dear Brothers and Sisters,
Glory to Jesus Christ!**

This official notice is to inform you that during this week a meeting was convened by His Eminence Archbishop Michael with Fr. James Worthington, at the Diocesan Chancery. During extensive and prayerful deliberations, His Eminence made a decision with Fr. James, that effective immediately, Fr. James is officially relieved of his duties as Acting Rector of Holy Trinity Church in Elmira Heights.

The canonical process of returning Fr. James to status of layman will take place in keeping with established ecclesiastical procedures. Concurrently, His Eminence appointed Very Rev. Archpriest Timothy Holowatch Temporary Priest-in-Charge of Holy Trinity parish, while the process of search for a new Parish Priest is undertaken by Archbishop Michael.

We ask for your continued prayers for Fr. James, Fr. Timothy, Fr. Nikolay and myself, as we will go together through this time of transition in our beloved parish. Assuring you of my prayers and love, I remain yours in Christ,
