All- American Council Convenes in St. Louis, MO “For the Life of the World”

As widely anticipated, the **19th All-American Council [AAC]** of the Orthodox Church in America will open in Saint Louis, MO on Monday, July 23, 2018. Hundreds of OCA and guest hierarchs, clergy and lay delegates, youth, and observers are expected to attend the week-long gathering. Traditionally referred to as a **“Sobor,”** the Council embraces the diversity of persons within the Body of Christ while manifesting the Apostolic unity of faith in the All-Holy Trinity: Father, Son, Holy Spirit. The Council will be a manifestation of the Church as the community of worship, in the fullness of Orthodoxy, seeking to discern the will of God regarding various spiritual and administrative deliberations and decisions. The theme of the Council is: **“For the Life of the World.”** Fr. Alexey and Fr. Timm are attending on our behalf.
