The Feast Days of August: The month of August presents to us three Feasts of the Savior, in addition to the start of the Dormition Fast and the Great Feast of the Dormition (Falling asleep of the Theotokos) **Join us this Tuesday at 6:00pm for Great Vespers for the Feast of the Procession of the Cross, with the Blessing of Honey.**



Next up is the **Feast of the Transfiguration on August 5th & 6th**, which will be celebrated with Great Vespers following the Fellowship Hour next Sunday. We will also Bless Fruit at this time and invite you to bring your fruit baskets.

The Great Feast of the Dormition is celebrated on Wednesday, August 15th - we will join our Brothers and Sisters at Dormition Church in Binghamton along with Archbishop MICHAEL for the Feast.

The third and final **Feast of the Savior is on August 16th**, when we commemorate the Translation of the Image "Not-Made-By-Hands" of our Lord Jesus Christ.
