General Confession: Beginning in October, we will institute a service of General Confession once a month following a Saturday Vespers. All regular communicants should participate in this service as a preparation for receiving Holy Communion. General Confession is proposed as a "school of repentance," as a means of strengthening one's spiritual life and bolstering one's experience of individual Confession. General Confession does not replace the need for regular private Confession but rather helps to encourage a more faithful practice of confession prior to the reception of Holy Communion. Look for an announcement in an upcoming bulletin on when this service will be offered.
